The open-to-public library covers a substantial area on the third floor of Oman Avenues Mall. The area is covered with bookshelves, children's play area, colourful slides as props, comfortable seating areas, educational toys and a bus-themed bookshop to signify and promote the mobile bus libraries that Dar Al Atta'a runs across Oman to reach out to children who do not have access to libraries.

The books on display are available for purchase at a subsidised rate, and the resulting sale proceeds would be reinvested into the development and management of the project. Children are welcome to donate their own books to the Let's Read bookshop at the deposit boxes put up at key points in the mall, and inside the library too.

The entire fit out and project cost was undertaken by Oman Avenues Mall, while Dar Al Atta'a will manage the book collections and management of the project under a two-year, renewable management programme.
